Do four activities to complete this Brownie Try-It.

- 1a. On a globe or world map find the United States.
Look for Vermont. Be able to point to it on the globe or map.
What country is next to Vermont? What states share our borders?
- 1b. Look at a map of Vermont. See if you can find all of the following places. Draw and color your own map of Vermont including all of the places listed here. You can copy the outline of the state.
 - The state capital.
 - The county, city or town where you live.
 - The Mississquoi River, the White River and the Lamoille River.
 - Montpelier, Burlington, Rutland, St. Johnsbury, Bennington and Springfield.
 - Lake Champlain.
 - The Green Mountains including Mount Mansfield and Camel's Hump.
 - The Long Trail.
2. Find out about interesting state information for Vermont. Draw or cut out pictures of each. Share what you have learned with your families.
 - The state bird.
 - The state tree.
 - The state flower.
 - The state flag.
 - The state nickname.
 - The state song – can you learn to sing it?
 - The design on the Vermont quarter.
 - Where the name "Vermont" comes from?
 - When Vermont became a state and what number state Vermont was in joining the Union.
3. Visit a local historical society or a place of historical interest with your troop or your family. Share what you learned with your troop or family.
4. Who were two presidents from Vermont?
 - When and where were they born?
 - What number presidents were they?
 - What was special about them?
5. Who was Ethan Allen? Who were the Green Mountain Boys and why were they important?
6. Write a letter or postcard to a government official. Ask her about her job. Ask her about an issue that concerns you or your troop/group.
