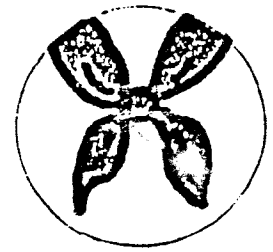

- *1. Practice and perform "The Wyoming Girl Scout Council Style Show" using the history of the uniforms (which is enclosed with uniforms) and incorporating your choice of other requirements.

2. Select a version of the Promise from years gone by and perform it with the Promise of today.
3. Put on a skit during a segment of the show, depicting Juliette Low's life.
4. Select a version of the Law from years gone by and perform it with the Law of today.
5. Learn at least 3 Girl Scout hand signs and incorporate them into your style show.
6. Show the steps of 2 different badges you could have earned more than 30 years ago.
7. Add a uniform of today to your style show, or design a uniform of the future.
(We are Talkin' Space Age!)
- *8. Publicize your style show by doing one of the following: posters, invitations, T.V. spots, or radio spots.
- *9. Invite a consultant that can teach your troop the proper etiquette to use in performing your style show.
10. Practice and perform some Girl Scout songs within your style show.
