*a Try-It for Brownie Girl Scouts*



*Complete four of the seven requirements:*

1.	Watch the history of the 10 <sup>th</sup> Mountain Division. Watch the video <i>Fire on the Mountain</i> that tells the early history of the 10 <sup>th</sup> Mountain Division. The first 20 minutes of the video discusses pre-war activities. Most of the remainder of the video is about WWII and may not be appropriate for all girls.
2.	View the history of the 10 <sup>th</sup> Mountain Division via a trip to the Fort Drum and 10 <sup>th</sup> Mountain Division Museum's <i>Historical Collection</i> to see equipment, uniforms, and display items used by soldiers since WWII.
3.	Tour the Division Headquarters (Hays Hall, Building P-10,000) and view the history, equipment, photo displays, etc. of the 10 <sup>th</sup> Mountain Division. Call 315.772.6155 to schedule your tour.
4.	Visit the 10 <sup>th</sup> Mountain Division Monument <i>Military Mountaineers</i> . Discuss the significance of the design.
5.	Make an art project of the 10 <sup>th</sup> Mountain Division patch. Discuss the significance of the different parts of the patch.
6.	Learn to sing the 10 <sup>th</sup> Mountain Division song.
7.	Learn about the deployment of the 10 <sup>th</sup> Mountain Division, the most deployed division in the Army since 1990. Discuss the places, missions, and significance of these deployments.
