Arizona Native American Brownie Try-It

There are twenty-two recognized tribes in the State of Arizona. Most tribes have their own language, religious and ceremonial customs, way of dress, and laws. This Try-It has been developed in order to learn about an individual tribe of our choice and to expand your knowledge of other tribes.

Brownie Girl Scouts complete the one starred item plus three other activities.

- *1. Choose one of the recognized tribes of Arizona. Find its location on an Arizona map. Do they have a native language? Learn to say hello and good-by. What does their traditional dress look like?**
- 2. Visit a museum or see a display of Native American objects.**
- 3. Read or listen to a Native American story or poem.**
- 4. Make a Native American recipe. Serve and taste it.**
- 5. Native American games were designed to practice skill development. Learn to play a Native American game.**
- 6. Attend a special Indian event such as a dance competition.**
- 7. Try a Native American craft such as pottery making, basketry, weaving, or beading.**
- 8. Find out about the life of a Native American heroine such as Sacagawea, Wilma Mankiller, or Pocahontas.**
