REQUIREMENTS: Complete a minimum of five of the following activities including the two that are starred. Share “troopwork” with others.

- *1. Vist the Chamber of Commerce, 201 B Temple Avenue. Contact Lamese Essey at 526-5872. Take note of the display rack with historic information, business information, and city information.
- *2. Vist Violet Bank Museum, 303 Virginia Avenue. Headquarters for Robert E. Lee in 1864, early 18th Century Architecture, and 2nd Largest Cucumber Tree in the world. Contact Rusty Woodburn 520-9395 or woodburnr@colonial-heights.com.
3. Vist the Brick House, Conjurers Neck. 1685 Construction and Indian Burial Grounds. Contract Jo Ann Jones at 526-2695.
4. Vist Shepherd Stadium. 901 Meridian Avenue. 54-Year Old Baseball Facility which has had 9 Baseball Hall of Fame Players at BIB Tournament as celebrities and has hosted Minor League Baseball. Contact Sean Gleason at 520-9224 or gleasons@colonial-heights.com.
5. Take a walking tour of Fort Clifton and identify plants, trees and shrubbery. Battle of Fort Clifton held in 1864, Earthworks, marshland, & Appomattox River Park has a nationally recognized butterfly garden at the entrance. Located on Brockwell Lane. Contact Sean Gleason at 520-9224
6. Take a walking tour of White Bank Park and Archer Avenue Property to learn the Indian History of White Bank Park and Archer Avenue while learning about the Appomattox River. Contact Sean Gleason at 520-9224.
7. Vist Old City Hall, 512 Boulevard, now the home of the Colonial Heights School Administration. Old City Hall housed the Fire Department, Court Room, and City Administration. Contract School Board Office at 526-0811
