



# Brownie Fishing Try-It

Choose 4 activities to complete this Try-It.

1. Learn about our local fishing regulations. Find out why they are important.
2. Learn about the different kinds of equipment used for fishing (the different rods, reels and bait).
3. Learn how to assemble the fishing equipment, string the line, and properly tie on a hook.
4. Learn how to cast a line safely. Practice casting (using only a weight – no hook) toward a target at least 25 feet away.
5. Find out about a fish that lives in your state. Be able to identify its different parts (fins, tail, eyes, mouth, scales, etc.).
6. Try to catch a fish. What are some safety rules you should know before going fishing?
7. Invite an experienced fisher-person to visit your troop.
